AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THROUGH TRAFFIC ON MCLAUGHLIN STREET

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 14-2001

WHEREAS, the Town of Eastover (Town) desires to insure the safety and well-being of the Town's resident or visitor;

WHEREAS, there is a major concern that due to the new elementary school's location that McLaughlin Street will be used by parents as a drop off and pickup point which will cause congestion and will prove to be a hazard for the children if they are not picked up/dropped off at the school entrance; and

WHEREAS, the Town sees fit to prevent any such hazard and traffic congestion;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, in a meeting duly assemble:

- 1. Through traffic shall be prohibited on McLaughlin Street for a period of one hour in the morning, thirty minutes before school begins at Webber Elementary School continuing until thirty minutes after school begins (currently 7:00 a.m. 8:00 a.m.). Through traffic shall also be prohibited on McLaughlin Street in the afternoon for a period of ninety minutes (currently 2:30 p.m. 3:30 p.m.). The specific times set forth in this Ordinance shall be adjusted if Webber Elementary School's Hour change.
- 2. Sings shall be posted on McLaughlin Street to notify drivers and the public of this prohibition;
- 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately following its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
