AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES
ORDINANCE #3-1005

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILPERSONS IN COUNCIL
MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED

**SECTION 1. SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEE FOR COMMERCIAL
DWELLINGS**

An annual fee of \$160.00 per town of Eastover issued container shall be charged to every business, firm, corporation, or association existing for commercial purposes within the Town of Eastover. This fee shall be amended by act of the mayor and council from time to time. Failure to pay the solid waste collection fee within fifteen (15) days of billing shall be a misdemeanor. The Town of Eastover may use all legal methods to assure payment.

**SECTION 2. SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEE FOR RESIDENTIAL
DWELLINGS**

An annual fee of \$136.00 per town of Eastover issued container shall be charged to the dwelling unit of every resident, person or persons existing for residential purposes within the Town of Eastover. This fee shall be amended by act of the mayor and council from time to time. Failure to pay the solid waste collection fee within fifteen (15) days of billing shall be a misdemeanor. The Town of Eastover may use all legal methods to assure payment.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any portion of this amendment is ruled invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES

Any prior ordinance or parts of ordinances or code provisions that are inconsistent with provisions hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This amendment shall be in full force and effect immediately following its passage, approval and publication by law.

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE RATES FOR TOWN LIGHTING.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 8-2000

WHEREAS, South Carolina Electric and Gas ("SCE&G") is currently providing 129 streetlights to the Town of Eastover ("Eastover");

WHEREAS, SCE&G has agreed to install fifteen additional streetlights;

WHEREAS, Eastover is currently charging town residents \$1.28 per month for costs associated with providing the streetlights;

WHEREAS, SCE&G is currently incurring a monthly deficit of \$308.72 per month as the difference between the cost for the streetlight and the revenue generated by the current rate of \$1.28 per month per customer;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Eastover Town Council ("Council") hereby agrees to an increase in town lighting rates for the town residents to \$ 3.84 per month to cure the deficit and to provide for fifteen additional streetlights.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with SCE&G on behalf of Eastover effectuate the rate adjustment and additional service provided for herein.

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE RATES FOR TOWN LIGHTING.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 8-2000

WHEREAS, South Carolina Electric and Gas ("SCE&G") is currently providing 129 streetlights to the Town of Eastover ("Eastover");

WHEREAS, SCE&G has agreed to install fifteen additional streetlights;

WHEREAS, Eastover is currently charging town residents \$1.28 per month for costs associated with providing the streetlights;

WHEREAS, SCE&G is currently incurring a monthly deficit of \$308.72 per month as the difference between the cost for the streetlight and the revenue generated by the current rate of \$1.28 per month per customer;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Eastover Town Council ("Council") hereby agrees to an increase in town lighting rates for the town residents to \$ 3.84 per month to cure the deficit and to provide for fifteen additional streetlights.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with SCE&G on behalf of Eastover effectuate the rate adjustment and additional service provided for herein.

ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE #8-2000

WHEREAS, the Town of Eastover ("Town") enacted Ordinance No. 8-2000 on June 4, 2001 which provided for South Carolina Electric & Gas ("SCE&G") to charge a flat rate of \$3.84 per resident for street lights in the Town; and

WHEREAS, SCE&G agreed to change the current monthly charge from \$3.90 (Rate Code 64/4) to \$3.51 per resident (Rate Code 64/5) with the understanding that this Rate Code is not fixed and will change periodically due to fuel costs and/or general rate changes as approved by the South Carolina Public Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Town adopted a Resolution on January 7, 2002 in order to accept Rate Code 64/5 to benefit the Town's residents; and

WHEREAS, SCE&G has advised that Ordinance No. 8-2000 must be repealed prior to SCE&G putting the new Rate Code into effect in the Town.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town hereby repeals Ordinance #8-2000.
