AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A TAX RATE OF 121.2 MILLS AND LEVYING AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES TO PROVIDE REVENUES IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$ 145,000.00) AND ANY ADDITIONAL AMOUNT APPROVED BY THE TOWN OF EASTOVER PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2000 FOR THE GENERAL FUND DURING THE PERIOD JULY 1, 1999 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2000.

Ordinance Number 4-1002

Pursuant to the authority granted by the Constitution and the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EASTOVER:

SECTION I. Rate. There shall be levied upon all taxable property in the Town of Eastover an ad valorem tax at the rate of 121.2 mills, which, together with the prior year's carryover and inventory tax reimbursement, will provide revenue in the amount of One Hundred and Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$ 145,000.00), and any additional amounts appropriated by the Town of Eastover prior to July 1, 2000, for the General Fund during the period from July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2000.

SECTION II. Severability. If any section, subsection, or clause of this ordinance shall be deemed unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, or clauses shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION III. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of the ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be enforced and effective from and after July 1, 1999.
