AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN OF EASTOVER

ORDINANCE # <u>5-1002</u>

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILPERSONS IN COUNCIL MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this code, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Storage shall mean the leaving or parking of such vehicle unattended on a street for a longer time than two hours, day or night.

Commercial Vehicle shall mean any vehicle used for the delivery of goods and services served to advance or market the promotions of any business, firm, corporation or association assembled for non-residential purposes.

SECTION 2. PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES PROHIBITED

No person shall store or permit to be stored any commercial vehicle upon any of the streets or residential neighborhoods within the Town of Eastover.

SECTION 3. PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS OF TOWN OF EASTOVER DECLARED A PUBLIC NUISANCE

- A. No person shall stop, stand or park a commercial vehicle within a residential neighborhood of the Town of Eastover for any purpose or period of time other than for expeditious loading or unloading of passengers and then only for a period not to exceed three (3) minutes.
- B. No person shall stop, stand or park a commercial vehicle within a residential neighborhood of the Town of Eastover for any purpose or length of time other than for expeditious unloading and delivery or pickup and loading of materials in any place marked as a loading zone during the hours of 8:00a.m. to 11:00 a.m., Monday through Saturday. In no case shall the stop for loading and unloading of materials exceed thirty (30) minutes. Unless otherwise posted by the traffic engineer, any commercial vehicle may occupy a loading zone on Sunday, or for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes after 11:00 a.m. and before 8:00 a.m. on Monday through Saturday.

SECTION 4. PENALTY

Any person convicted of violating this Section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined no more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or imprisoned no more than 30 days.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY

If any portion of this ordinance is ruled invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES

Any prior ordinance or parts of ordinances or code provisions that are inconsistent with provisions hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately following its passage, approval and publication by law.
