AN ORDINANCE TO ADD SECTION 8-1005 TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES SO AS PROHIBIT STOCK AND CATTLE FROM RUNNING AT LARGE ON THE STREETS OF THE TOWN OF EASTOVER. SOUTH CAROLINA, TO PROVIDE FOR PERMITS ISSUED BY THE MAYOR OR MAYOR PRO TEMPORE WHEN PROHIBITED ANIMALS ARE USED IN EDUCATIONAL OR ENTERTAINMENT PROGRAMS OF SHORT DURATION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of EASTOVER in meeting assembled;

SECTION 1	It shall be unlawful for any person or persons or corporations or firms or association to keep swine, hogs, pigs, horses, mules, cows, sheep, goats, or other caule or stock within the Town limits of Eastover.
SECTION 2	It shall be unlawful for the owner of or person having in his or her control any horse, mule, cow, sheep, goat or other caule or stock to allow same to run at large within the Town limits of Eastover.
SECTION 3	The Mayor or in the absence of the Mayor the Mayor pro tempore may issue a person or organization conducting an event or program for educational or entertainment purposes of limited duration, not to exceed two days, a permit which allows the display of prohibited animals within the corporate limits upon paying a permit fee and positing such financial assurance or bond as maybe set at tempore.
SECTION 4	Any violation of this ordinance shall be punished, upon conviction, by a fine of no less than Twenty-five (\$25,00) Dollars and not more than Two Hundred (\$200,00 Dollars or by imprisonment for not less than ten (10) days and not more than thirty
SECTION 5	THAT this ordinance shall go in effect immediately on passage.
